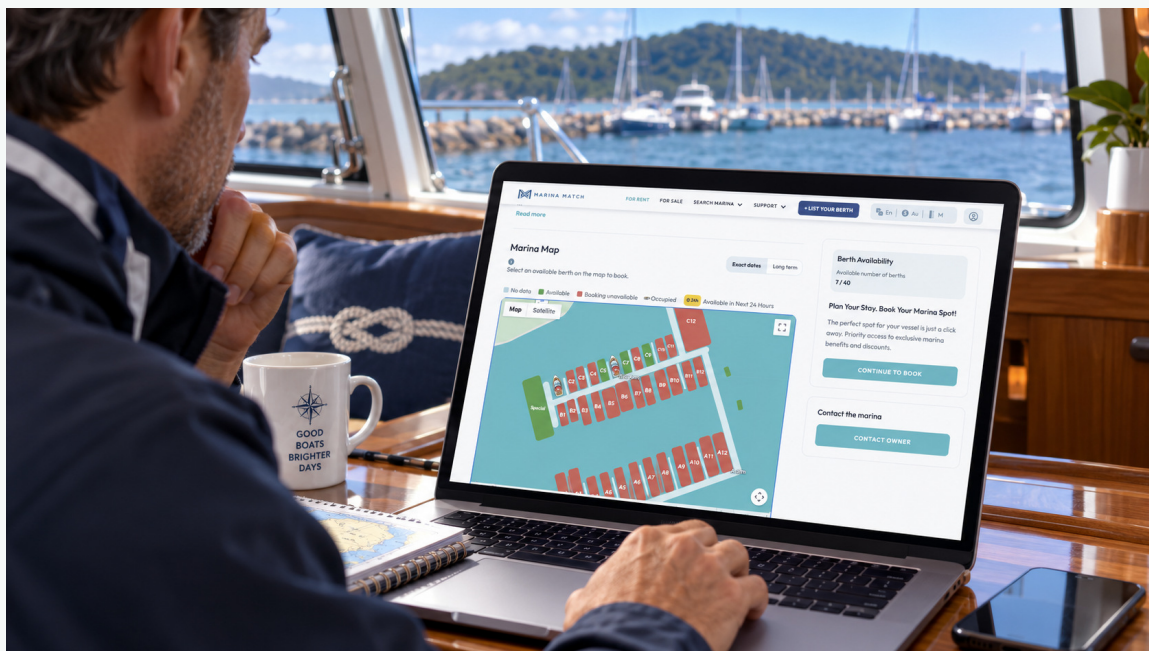

An available berth is an opportunity. Help boaters find it.



VISIBLE BEYOND OFFICE HOURS

24/7

Your published availability can be discovered while boaters plan their journey, even when your marina office is closed.

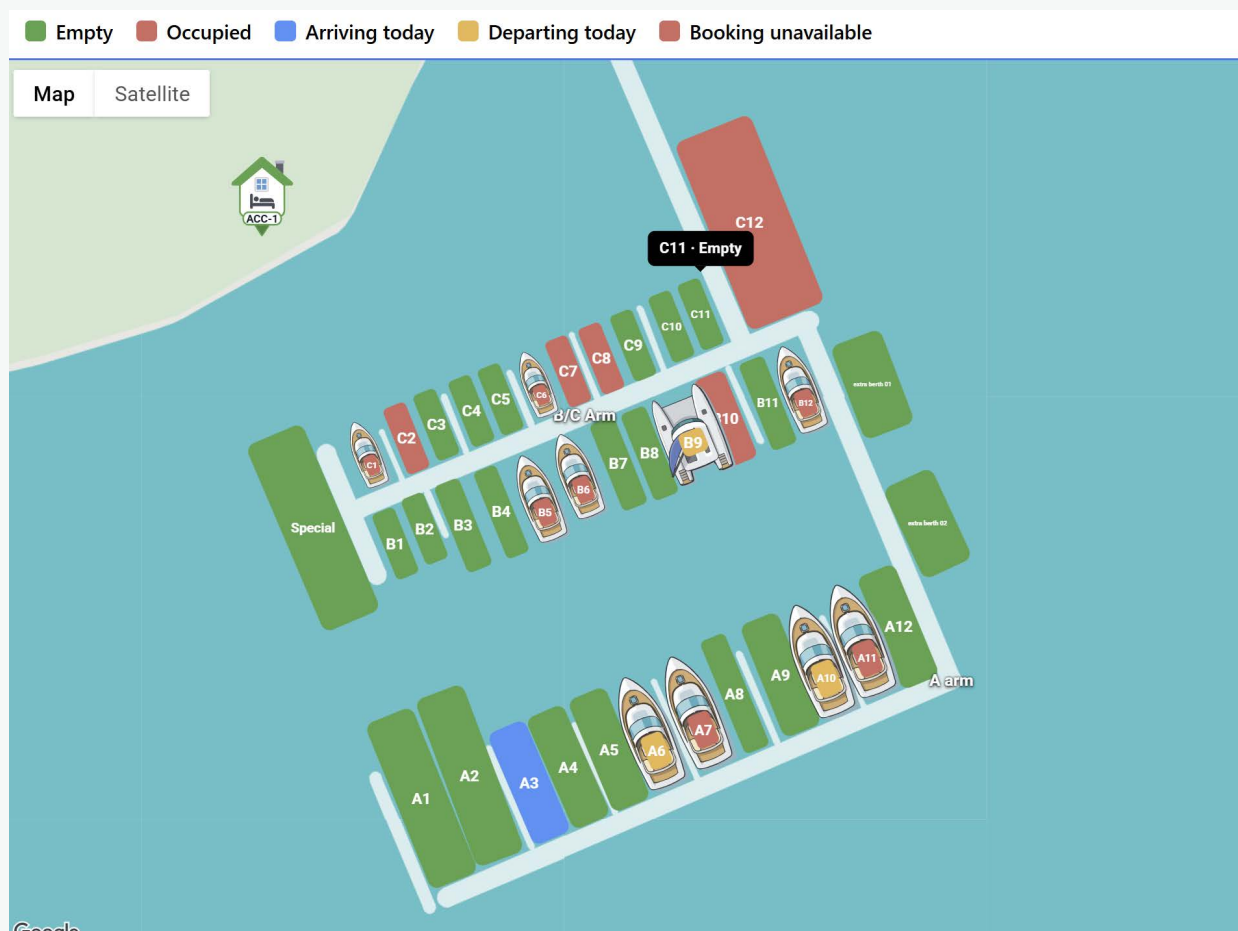
Search. Select. Book.

Destination, dates and vessel details help boaters find a suitable place to stay.

Connect the berth you have with the boater looking for it.

See the marina. Understand the day.

A live operational view connects your physical layout with berth information and vessel locations.



Read availability visually.

See berth status and vessel locations together on the map.

Open the berth details.

Check dimensions, pricing and availability from the visual layout.

Keep the team informed.

Use the full-screen wall display for an at-a-glance view of the marina.

Vessel icons show boat locations. Yellow indicates an occupied berth becoming available within 24 hours.

Your layout changes. Your map can too.

Build and maintain the marina map from the Dock Master dashboard. Saved changes are reflected in the live platform automatically.



- 1 Draw your marina.**
Place piers, jetties and individual berths.
- 2 Make it fit.**
Position and rotate berths to match the layout.
- 3 Keep it current.**
Edit berth details and save changes as the marina evolves.

Draw. Position. Update. Your live map stays connected.

Change one berth. Or manage many.

Keep berth dimensions, prices and availability aligned with the way your marina operates.

INDIVIDUAL BERTH CONTROL

Size & suitability

Update length, width and the details boaters need to assess fit.

Price & availability

Set the rate and manage the periods a berth can be booked.

BULK CHANGES FOR BUSY TEAMS

Select the berths or dates you need, then apply a shared update.

Availability

Open or block selected periods.

Pricing

Adjust rates by an amount or percentage.

Billing & discounts

Apply billing periods and discounts in bulk.

Spend less time repeating the same update across your marina.

From search to confirmed stay.

For suitable, available berths enabled for instant booking, boaters can complete the booking and payment online.

Search

Enter a destination, dates and vessel details.

2

Select

Compare suitable berths, prices and availability.

3

Book & pay

Complete payment and receive booking confirmation.

The booking, boater details and vessel information are ready for your team.

When a booking needs a human touch.

If the requested berth is unavailable, the size does not suit, or the stay needs your input, keep the conversation moving with a booking request.

01

Request a booking

The boater sends their dates, vessel details and requirements.

**02**

Review & send an offer

Check a suitable alternative berth, dates and price. Send a tailored offer.

**03**

Accept & pay

The boater reviews the offer and completes acceptance and payment.

Plans changed? Keep managing the booking.

Review change or extension requests, adjust the berth, dates or price, and send the revised offer for acceptance where required.

No suitable option yet? Use enquiries and waitlists to keep track of future demand.

A home port deserves a connected system.

Manage ongoing berthing relationships alongside visitor bookings.

MY HOME PORT

Long-term stays. Everyday visibility.

Keep the arrangement together.

Connect the boater, vessel, home berth, payment history and changes to the berthing arrangement.

Support regular payments.

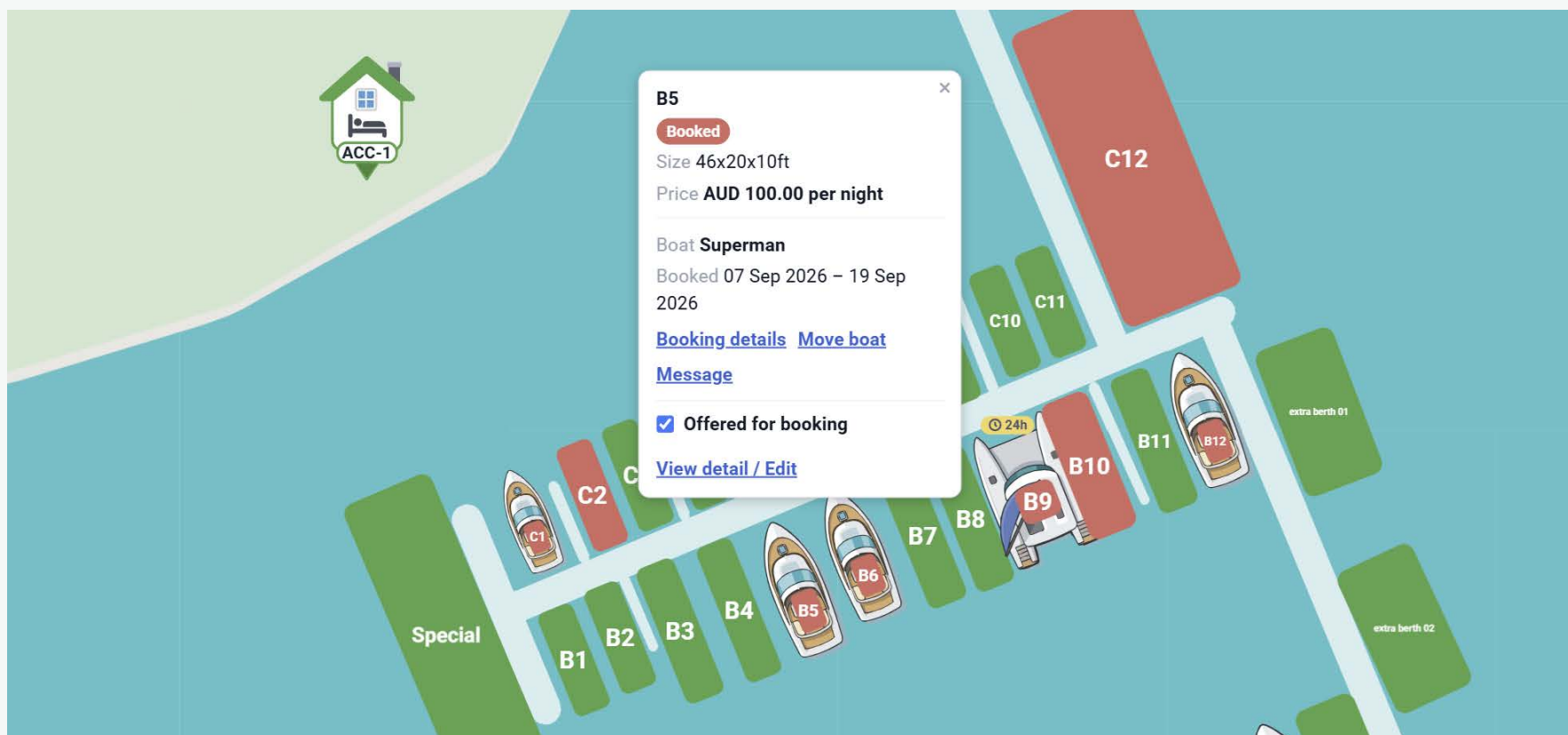
Manage recurring monthly payments where enabled and agreed. Boaters can view payment history and receipts in their account.



One platform for overnight visitors and the boats that call your marina home.

Move the boat. Update the location.

Use the berth edit menu or map tool to change the vessel's assigned berth when you need to reorganise space, accommodate a stay or prepare for maintenance.



Check the destination berth's fit and availability, make the allocation change and save. The updated vessel location is visible through the platform.

Booked. Paid. Easy to follow.

A connected booking and payment flow reduces routine administration for your marina team.

1 The boater pays online.

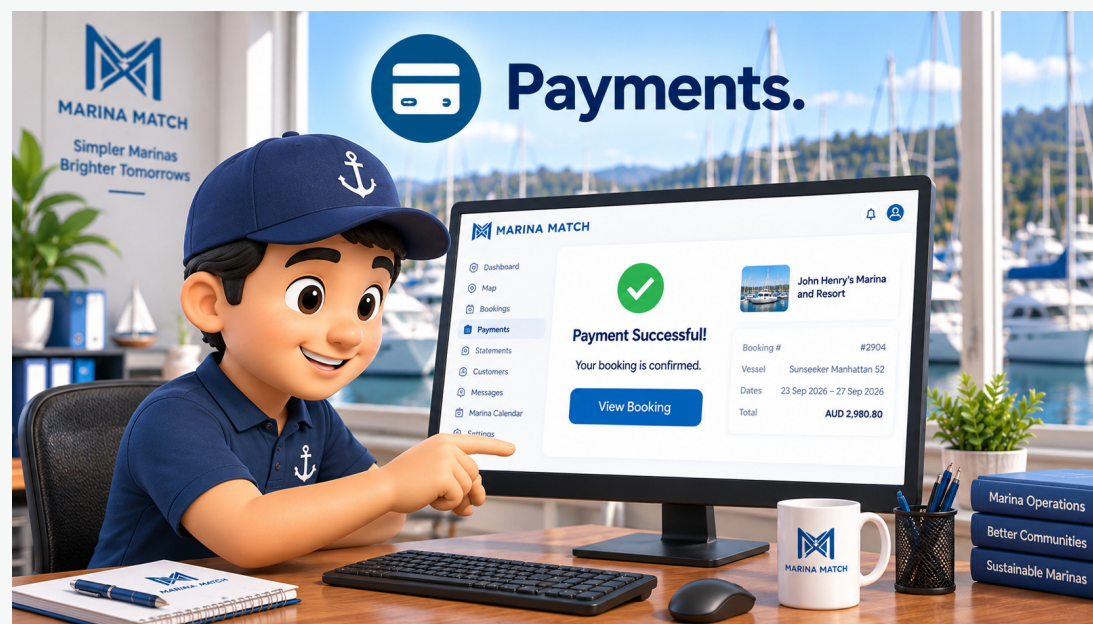
Booking payment is completed through Marina Match.

2 Marina Match issues the receipt.

The boater receives a receipt for the payment.

3 Your team sees the transaction.

Review payment and transaction information from the Dock Master dashboard.



Less routine invoice preparation for online berth bookings. A clearer record of what has been paid.

Online payments are processed through Stripe.

Handle the extras without the chase.

Berth fees are only part of marina life. Keep booking-related charges connected to the stay.

REQUEST ADDITIONAL PAYMENT

**Open the booking.
Add the charge.
Send the request.**

The boater can review the request and pay online. Your team can follow the transaction from the Dock Master dashboard.

No need to collect or store the boater's card details yourself.

EXAMPLES OF ADDITIONAL CHARGES

Electricity

Usage during the stay

A deposit connected to marina access

Know who is arriving. Keep the context.

Less repeated paperwork for boaters. More useful information for the team welcoming them.



One profile. Multiple bookings.

Reusable boater and vessel profiles connect contact details, dimensions and relevant documents to the booking.



Conversations with context.

Keep the boater, vessel, berth and booking connected to the conversation. Follow messages through Marina Match.

Bring membership and berthing into the same operational picture.



Connect membership & berthing.

Manage member information alongside boater details and bookings.

Support member access.

Guide boaters through the membership process where berths are reserved for members.

Set up your payout account for rental listings that take payments through Marina Match.

A MARKETPLACE FOR OWNERSHIP TOO

Help the right buyer find your berth.



Create a clear sale listing.

Present the location, price, dimensions, photos and relevant ownership or tenure details.

Be discovered & compared.

Reach people searching for marina berths, private docks and jetty opportunities.

Connect with interested buyers.

Discuss the listing, arrange a viewing and progress enquiries with prospective buyers.

A payout account is not required to publish sale-only listings.

Make the move manageable.

Start with a clear picture of your current operation, then build a practical path into Marina Match.

01 Prepare your information

Gather berth dimensions, rates, availability, active bookings and long-term berthing arrangements.

02 Build & check your map

Draw the layout, position berths and check the details against the marina on the water.

03 Set up booking & payments

Choose booking settings and cancellation policies. Complete payout setup for paid rental listings.

04 Walk through the daily tasks

Check a booking, send an offer, request a payment and practise updating a vessel's berth location.

Agree how existing records will be brought across and checked before your team changes systems.

Picture your next working day.

Explore Marina Match using the situations your team handles every week.

01 A berth becomes available.

Update its availability and see how a boater discovers and books it.

02 A boat needs a different option.

Review the request, adjust the berth or dates and send an offer.

03 A stay changes.

Explore an extension, revised price or move to another suitable berth.

04 An extra charge is due.

Send the payment request and follow the transaction in the dashboard.
